



PRIZES: Rosettes 1st-6th place Traditional monthly points and annual trophies.
All other classes/sections to be awarded Annual trophies to horse rider combination gaining the most points.

Rules:

- The judge's decision is final, any objections must be made to the secretary in writing together with a deposit of £20 which will be forfeited if the objection is not upheld, or is frivolous.
- All ages as of the 1st January in the current year
- Show jumping classes will be judged under BSJA rules.
- Maximum of three jumping classes on one horse/pony.
- Please use litter bins provided.
- All dogs must be kept on a lead and poops scooped.
- The organizers reserve the right to cancel or amend a class at any time.
- Excessive use of artificial aids or abuse of horse/ponies will not be tolerated, any person seen to be doing so, will be asked to leave the show ground.
- The club or its officials cannot be responsible for damage loss or injury to persons or animals due to accident or any other cause.
- The organizers have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and obey instructions of the organizers.
- **Correct attire and footwear** must be worn at all times when mounted.
- **Hard hats** to be worn at all times with chin strap securely fastened, standards to be met EN 1384, ASTM f1163, pas 015.
- Fall of rider. Rider will not be allowed to remount and will be asked to leave the area on foot.
- **All trophies must be returned in a clean condition for the start of the class otherwise points will be deducted.**
- No horse/pony to be entered twice in any one competitive class.
- Lead rein ponies must compete in snaffle bits
- Lead rein rider can only enter Lead Rein classes

BEST KEPT PONY AND TACK:

Class 1A: Lead rein: Riders to be 8 years and under.
Class 1B: Junior. Riders to be 9 years to 13 years.
Class 1C: Senior. Riders to be 14 years and over.

IN HAND:

Class 2A: 13.2hh & Under.
Class 2B: Over 13.2hh.
Class 3: Veteran Horse / Pony (Horse / Pony to be 16 and over)
Class 4: Young Handler. Handlers to be over 8 years and under 16years
Royal London Qualifiers - cards will be split in 2 sections (age governed)

BEST RIDER:

Class 5A: Lead rein. Riders to be 8 years and under.
Class 5B: First Ridden: Riders to be 10 years and under.
Class 5C: Junior. Riders to be 11 years to 13 years.
Class 5D: Senior. Riders to be 14 years and over.

FAMILY PONY/HORSE: - (snaffle bits and no artificial aids i.e.martingales etc)

Class 6A: Family Pony 14.2hh and under. Riders 16yrs and under.
Class 6B: Family Horse: Horses over 14.2hh. Riders any age.

NB: Senior Riders riding ponies under 14.2hh must enter family horse.

Classes 6A B may include the maximum of 2 fences.

Classes 6A B will be combined if insufficient entry's.

SHOW JUMPING CLASSES START AT 11.00am PROMPT

Class 8: CRADLE STAKES: Rider 8 years and under on 01/01/2010 ponies not to exceeds 12.2hh or 128cms.

Section A: Assisted, riders to be lead in both rounds.

Section B: Unassisted.

Class 9: NURSERY STAKES: Riders 9 to 11 Years on 01/01/2010. and NOT TO HAVE WON THREE JUMPING CLASSES

Riders to be on ponies not exceeding 14.2hh or 148cm. First Round Fence Height not to exceed 55cm.

Class 10: 2FT (60 cm)

Section A: Restricted - Riders 12 years and under on the 01/01/10 and ponies not exceeding 12.2hh 0r 128cm.

Section B: Unrestricted – Open to horses or ponies, riders any age.

Class will be split if entry's warrant (12 or more entries)

Class 11: 2' 3 (65 cm)

Section A: Restricted - Riders 14 years and under on the 01/01/2010 and ponies exceeding 12.2hh or 128cm and not exceeding 13.2hh or 138cm.

Section B: Unrestricted – Open to horses or ponies, riders any age.

Class will be split if entry's warrant (12 or more entries)

Class 12: 2' 6 (75cm)

Section A: For riders 16 years and under on the 01/01/2010 and ponies exceeding 13.2hh or 138cm and not exceeding 14.2hh or 148cm.

Section B: Unrestricted – Open to horses or ponies, riders any age.

Class will be split if entry's warrant (12 or more entries)

Class 13: 2' 9 (85cm)

Open to horses or ponies, riders any age.

Class will be split if entry's warrant (12 or more entries)

Class 14: 3' 1 - 3' 3 (95cm-1m)

Open to horses or ponies, riders any age.

Class will be split if entries warrant (12 or more entries)

All show jumping classes will be run under BSJA rules. Knock down, refusal, disobedience-4 faults. Two refusals will incur elimination. Fall of horse or/and rider incurs elimination. All show jumping classes with the will be run in A7 format.

In classes in which there are two sections please make clear which section you wish to enter, (A or B) B sections will be split in to Horses/Ponies only if entries warrant it.

The horse and rider combination may only compete in either section A or B. There are separate awards for each section if entries warrant it. Maximum of three jumping classes on one horse/pony. Qualification Cards – where applicable can be obtained from the appointed persons.
